CAN members will raise vital funds, volunteer with Calvary's life changing programs, and help expand our community with new corporate partner connections and donors. In addition, members will attend professional development opportunities, networking happy hours, and fundraising events.

What are the expectations for CAN members?

- Commitment of nine months (January-October), with opportunities to renew membership
- Attend first and last in-person meeting, plus bimonthly virtual meetings
- Attend one CAN mixer
- Fundraise and bring awareness to Calvary's work
- Complete four volunteer shifts at Calvary's program

What impact will I make as a CAN member?

- Volunteer alongside dedicated individuals who are driving meaningful change in our community
- Help continue to grow Calvary's life changing programs through fundraising
- Consult on new ways to expand the Calvary community of donors, volunteers, and community partners
- Participate in events, including the Hope Gala, Calvary's annual spring fundraiser, and the In This Together Annual Community Walk in the fall
- Be a catalyst for change by championing women at Calvary as they achieve their goals and end their homelessness for good
